



THE CEMETERY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING THAT IS LEFT AT THE GRAVE SITE.

1. The following items are **PROHIBITED** on graves: brick, stones (including crushed stone,) wire enclosures, glass containers, bushes, plants with thorns, toys, balloons, pinwheels, animal figures, open flame candles, wooden crosses or markers. **All means of enclosing a grave, including any kind of plantings or fencing is NOT ALLOWED.** The use of metal stands, legs or hooks is strictly prohibited. Any structure, planting, or decoration deemed to be offensive or improper, or if it impinges on another grave, the authorities of the cemetery shall have the right to remove said structure. This applies to the Columbarium niches as well. **NO OPEN FLAMES, including BARBECUES. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON GROUNDS.**
2. Natural cut flowers are approved and should be kept 6 to 8 inches in front of the marker or monument. No bushes or trees are permitted. The cemetery has a large deer population that may eat the natural cut flowers, bulbs, or perennials.
3. Foundation charges are NOT included in the opening of the grave charge. Foundation charges vary according to the size of the marker or monument permitted in that section of the cemetery. A completed permit with a drawing of the monument or marker including sizes must be on the permit. The cemetery will install the foundation after approval. **A local, licensed monument dealer must set the stone. The cemetery will NOT set the stone. Individual families are NOT PERMITTED to set the stone.**
4. The American, or other national flags, are permitted. They are required to be in flag holders to protect them. If not in a flag holder, they are permitted Memorial Day to Labor Day.
5. No transfer or assignment of any grave(s) shall be valid unless the cemetery is notified by notarized letter and records are changed.
6. The cemetery disclaims all responsibility of loss or damage of any kind caused by the elements, an act of God, thieves, common enemy, vandals, strikers, explosions, unavoidable accidents, or order of any civil or military authority.
7. The cemetery has the right to change the layout of any property or walkway within the grounds as they deem requisite and proper to secure and promote the general welfare of the cemetery. The cemetery reserves the right to change the rules and regulations at any time.
8. The cemetery is **closed to visitors at 5:30 pm daily** when the front gate is locked. **That means visitors must be gone by 5:30 pm.** The back gate, Menorah, and the mausoleum are closed at 4:00 pm. The Menorah Cemetery is closed on Saturdays.
9. All Christmas decorations will be removed February 1st. Holiday specific decorations will stay for 30 days after the holiday before being removed.
10. Dogs or other pets are not permitted on cemetery grounds. Service animals allowed.

WHY?

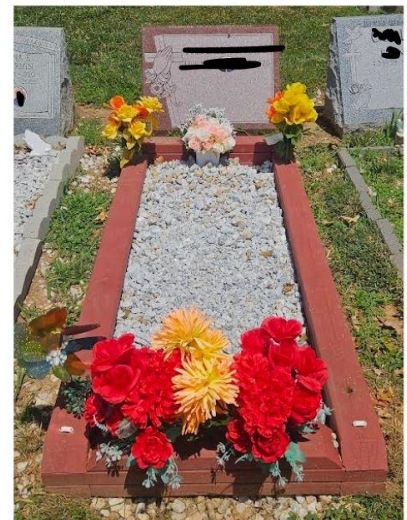
- Decorations are kept to about **18 inches** in front of the stone/foundation.
- Graves are kept neat and attended to by families
- Landscapers can access
- No broken items
- Not impeding on other's property
- No tripping hazards

Not Permitted

WHY?

- Decorations go passed the 18 inch mark
- Fencing, bricks, and pebbles outline grave making property impossible to reopen or reopen neighboring grave
- Outlining prevents landscapers from maintaining properly
- Pebbles this far down cause safety issues with mowers and mower-operators
- Tripping hazards for other visitors
- Broken items

There is a ROAD FEE of \$75.00 for all inscriptions. All fees for foundations **MUST** accompany orders. Please do not send payment without the proper paperwork to accompany it, i.e a permit & sketch with measurements. Foundations are poured from April-October.

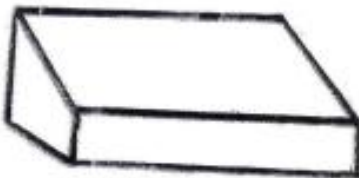

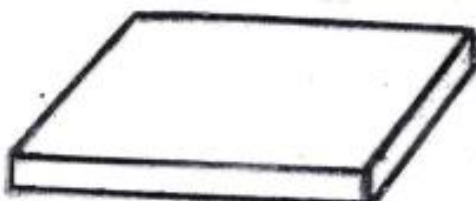

FAQs

Can I decorate my loved one's property?

You can decorate the top 18 inches of the grave. Anything beyond that is breaking our rules. Additionally, we are physically incapable of monitoring decorations left at gravesites so ANYTHING you leave is not the cemetery's responsibility to watch or maintain. We do not recommend leaving anything of value outside. You may NOT outline the length of the grave with fence, brick, or stones. Holiday-specific decorations are left for 30 days after said holiday. Christmas decorations are removed starting February 1st. Bushes and shrubs are not recommended as they tend to overgrow onto someone else's property. Also, there are deer, fox, and other wild animals who inhabit the cemetery that have been known to eat flowers. Excessive decorations make it near impossible to properly landscape.

How do I order a monument or marker for my loved one?

The grave owner must order from a local, licensed monument company, as a monument company must be the one to set the stone in the cemetery. Families can not set stones, and the cemetery will refuse delivery should you try to have the stone delivered directly to us. Once a local, licensed monument company is selected by the grave owner, the monument company will submit a sketch with measurements of the proposed stone to the cemetery with a foundation fee*. Once approved, the cemetery will let the monument company know that they may go ahead and create the stone. We will also let the monument company know when the foundation is completed and the stone can be set.

**The monument company will charge the grave owner the foundation fee and submit the payment along with the sketch and permit to the cemetery. The foundation fee is for the concrete that the stone will sit on top of. The fee depends on the size of the stone. The foundation fee is NOT included with the opening price and is guaranteed for 10 years. After 10 years, there will be a charge for any leveling that needs to be done. The permit must be signed by the grave owner.*

What size stone can I order?

Each section has different rules that also depend on how many graves were purchased. The office staff will be happy to go over that information with you, if you need.

What about photos on stones?

The cemetery does not recommend photos or etchings on the monument as they can be effected by severe weather easily. However, if the family elects to have one of their stone, they must sign a release acknowledging that the cemetery will not replace a weathered or deteriorating photo or etching.

For interment of full burials:

Vaults are required in most sections of the cemetery, unless explicitly told otherwise by the cemetery.

Can we use you for a cremation?

East Ridgelawn Cemetery does in fact have a crematory on premises, but we are just the facility. In the state of NJ, it is mandatory for a licensed funeral director to facilitate every cremation. Cemeteries/Crematories may NOT pick up remains and perform a cremation directly with a family. It must go through a funeral home. This does not mean you have to have a formal, traditional funeral. Any funeral home can facilitate this for you. You would call and ask for a "direct cremation," meaning you wish to simply have the cremation performed without a wake or funeral in the traditional sense. If you do wish to have a traditional funeral, you may as well. Same rules apply. That funeral home will facilitate everything for you and just use our crematory to perform said cremation.

What paperwork do I need for an interment of cremains?

A certificate of cremation for the decedent must be provided to the cemetery at or prior to the service by the next of kin. We can also accept a death certificate. (Can be a copy). Cremation service processions, with or without a funeral director, must wait at the flagpole to be led up to the gravesite by our staff.

What if I have another question, who should I ask?

If you have ANY questions pertaining to procedures or guidelines of the cemetery, please ask us. Even if a funeral home, monument company, or your personal friend/family is very familiar with our cemetery, we cannot take responsibility for incorrect information disseminated to you from anyone outside of our staff.

All rules and regulations are on the back of your deed and can be clarified by calling the office M-F 9 am - 3:30 pm
